

Springs School Community Service *Grade 8*

This year, due to Covid-19, completion of community service hours will be slightly different than in years past. Please read below for this year's expectations.

Expectations:

- Each student needs to get **AT LEAST 10 HOURS** of community service hours during 8th grade. These 10 hours are transferred to the high school. No more than 10 will be accepted by the high school but more than 10 hours is strongly encouraged!
- All hours are due by **JUNE 11th**
- When a community service activity has been finished, one must type in the information on the community service activity log on the next page. Coach King will sign off on the form at the end of the year.
- Students who have already completed their hours and turned them in do not need to do more unless they would like to add on to their already completed 10 hours.
- Students who complete **MORE THAN 50 HOURS** of community service will be awarded an individual plaque at graduation recognizing their commitment to serving the community.
- Students who complete the **MOST** community service hours (1 male and 1 female) will have their names engraved on a **NEW** plaque outside of the gym.
- Some examples of community service activities that you could do this year (but are not limited to) are:
 - Recording yourself reading a book for elementary students
 - Volunteering to pick up garbage on School Street
 - Helping out a teacher with class/community projects
 - Organizing a food drive
 - Volunteering at your local church, senior center, community organization
